Health Check Coffee Morning

Please do come along to a 'Coffee Morning with a Difference' on Saturday 20th June.

As well as providing the usual refreshments of tea, coffee and a selection of cakes the Parish Council will be facilitating individual clinical consultations consisting of a health check and healthy lifestyles advice.

These checks are delivered by specialists helping NHS Trusts across the UK to drive forward the implementation and delivery of their NHS Health Check programmes, with the ultimate aim of preventing heart disease, stroke, diabetes and kidney disease.

Each 20- to 30-minute session is carried out by a Healthy Lifestyles Advisor for 'ICE Creates' commissioned by Worcestershire County Council to deliver free NHS Health Checks to people between the ages of 40-74 years and a Smoking Cessation service to people aged 12+ years in Worcestershire.

All consultations will be held in complete privacy. Funds raised at this event will be forwarded to support the work of the Life After Stroke Centre in Bromsgrove.

If you are interested in the free health check or the smoking cessation support but cannot attend the coffee morning, please let us know and we will pass on your contact details.

All Bournheath parish residents are welcome to attend – we look forward to seeing you there!
